- the asylum procedure,
- the regulations on residence permits,
- the Dublin-procedure,
- detention,
- reopening of a case,
- deportation, etc.

## Confidentiality

All advisors are bound to observe strict confidentiality within the limits of the law.

## Translation

For counselling at the asylum centres the Danish Refugee Council will ensure that the assistance of interpreters in pre-selected languages is available.

We are not able to offer the assistance of an interpreter during counselling in Borgergade. Please bring an adult you trust to translate for you if necessary.
