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REJECTED – NOW WHAT?



Rejected – now what?

All rejected asylum seekers in Denmark are offered an explanatory consultation with an independent humanitarian organisation.

You have received this folder because you have had your application for asylum rejected. The decision is final and you may not appeal to another Danish authority or court. This means that your asylum case in Denmark has ended and the Danish authorities have decided that you must leave the country.

Now that you have received this decision, you may be uncertain or worried about what will happen if you return to your home country. You may have specific questions about leaving this country and the applicable rules for rejected asylum seekers. You may like to have a meeting where you can discuss your options and your situation if you return to your home country and would perhaps like to speak with one of our staff members stationed there.

You are entitled to an individual consultation to have your asylum rejection explained, get legal advice and discuss options and concrete questions that may be important for you in relation to returning to your home country. There will be an interpreter present at this meeting.

If you wish to have this meeting, please complete the form on the next page. Your signature on the form only means that you would like advice and not that you wish to return voluntarily.
